2018 marks the 90th birthday for the 7th Street Theatre! The 7th Street Theatre opened its doors on July 10, 1928, and we are planning to celebrate in a big way this year.

A special committee has banded together to create commemorative items and organize events next year to celebrate.

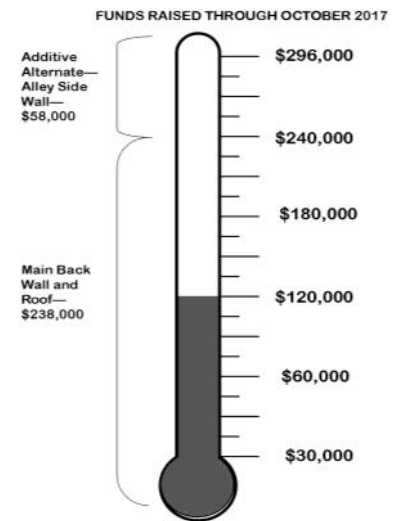

On April 14 there will be a slide show produced in partnership with the Polson Museum. It will focus on

what life was like in Hoquiam in 1928, specifically at the theatre. On August 25 a special birthday party is being planned, and the committee is working on at least one more event. ## Nearly half of funding received for back wall project!

We are pleased to announce that the theatre has been awarded a \$35,000 grant from the Grays Harbor Community Foundation, and a \$5,000 charitable gift from Timberland Bank. These funds, plus the \$75,000 we have set aside from our savings, bring us halfway to our fundraising goal for the back wall and roof replacement project. The main back wall and roof project is estimated at \$238,000. The alley side wall is another \$58,000, and if we receive enough funds that project will also be done at the same time. Currently we are submitting grant applications to foundations and asking the community for help with this project. The above photo shows one of the walls that need repair and the measurements are meant to provide a sense of the scale of this project. Water penetration of the two walls is currently a problem that is seven stories tall! At the moment, the theatre uses buckets and other containers during rainstorms to prevent further damage to the interior.
